After wiring Christmas funds to the children in December, **we wired \$15,626 for the children's 2020 school expenses in January.** We thank all of you who give generously throughout the year to our **Education Fund** to meet this need. Our children returned to school on February 3rd with their Annual School Admission Fees paid, and their uniforms, textbooks and school supplies purchased. **Our next goal for 2020 is to raise the money needed for our college students. The college tuition fees are \$600 per student this year. We are preparing to assist 15 college students, so our goal is to raise \$9000.** Every year the amount needed for college increases. **Please pray with us that once again, the funds for the education of our college students will be available by June of 2020.**
