

## BETHEL WELL PROJECT COMPLETED

Thanks to some generous supporters, as well as a grant from the ALLSTATE INSURANCE COMPANY, the Bethel Children's Home has a new well and water filtration tank. After finding water at a depth of 180 feet, in order to ensure adequate availability of water, the well (brick structure in picture below) was dug to a depth of 250 feet. The water filtration tank (gray concrete structure in back) holds 10,000 liters of clean water.
