PRAISE AND PRAYER UPDATES

- We exceeded our matching pledge donation of \$10,000 for our Education Fund. We raised a total of \$22,000. All of our children have returned to their classrooms this month, as Coronavirus restrictions have been lifted. PTL!
- We collected \$6841 to purchase Christmas gifts for our children.
 Clothing, mattresses, blankets, pillows, carpentry/masonry tools, a wardrobe and inverter were purchased with the donations. Still needed a refrigerator (\$800), an inverter (\$412), and 10 mattresses (\$60 each) for Bethel Children's Home.
- 3. We received \$850 in donations to build new living quarters for the Mercy Home boys in Nepal. Total amount needed is \$20,000. In the meantime, they are living in Pastor Janga's home. Once we raise \$5000, we plan to wire the money to Pastor Janga to build the foundation.
- 4. We anticipate having 22 students enrolled in college during the 2021/2022 Academic Year beginning in June. PTL! Cost for tuition will be \$650 per student (Total needed is \$14,300).
