Lucy Neng Nei Hoi (pictured above with her family) is a former HFC Sponsor Child who grew up in the Sanga Muon Orphanage (Manipur, Northeast India). She recently graduated from Churachandpur College with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science. She secured a teaching job at Gilgal High School in Sugunu, a small town in the Chandel District of Manipur. She is also raising two boys with her husband, Jangkhothong, who has a few acres of paddy fields which he farms for a living. Lucy's childhood was marred with her parents' feuding families. Both sides were against her parents' marriage, so when they both died, there was fighting over who should take care of her. Her grandmother brought her to the Sanga Muon Orphanage in 2006, when she was only seven years old. At the time of her admission to Sanga Muon, she told her caretakers she liked it there because she no longer had to bear the fighting of her elders. In a recent note of thanks she says, "I want you to know I'm making my own family. By the grace of God I'm blessed with two lovely sons."
